Related Arts....Explained!

At East we offer the following Related Arts Courses:

PE, Health, Art, Business, General Music, Band, Choir, and Orchestra

If your student is enrolled in Band/Choir/Orchestra....

If your student is enrolled in Band/Choir/Orchestra they will have that course all year long. In addition they will be enrolled in 3 of the 4 non-music related arts courses (PE, Art, Business, and Health). Students do not get to choose which three they are enrolled in, but our goal is to make sure each student gets each course over the course of their 3 years here.

If your student is not enrolled in Band/Choir/Orchestra...

If your student is not enrolled in Band/Choir/Orchestra they will take PE twice and also be enrolled in General Music, Art, Health, and Business.

The student below is a music student. Notice that band is all year long and the other courses rotate every 12 weeks. The first date under each term indicates the start date of each 12 weeks. In the example below, Business begins 7/30, Health begins 11/10, and Art begins 2/16. The second schedule is not a music student. The term dates stay the same but every related arts course is only 12 weeks long.

What is PRIDE?

PRIDE is listed as the last class of the day for the majority of our students. The purpose of PRIDE is to provide a scheduled time for students to receive enrichment, remediation, or extra help on an assignment for any one of their classes. A student in need of assistance can visit any one of their teachers by simply requesting a pass. Using the first schedule on the previous pages as an example.....

Let's say student A leaves her Pre-Algebra class 4th period not quite understanding what they just learned. To get additional assistance she would approach her Pre-Algebra teacher and ask for a pass to come back during PRIDE (the teacher can also initiate this process). The Pre-Algebra teacher would hand her a signed yellow PRIDE pass. When it is time for PRIDE the student would simply show her yellow pass to her PRIDE teacher, sign-out, and then return to her Pre-Algebra class.

If your student needs additional help, ask them about PRIDE!





Back to School Shopping?

Here is a quick reminder of our dress code for those back to school sales:

- Jeans and garments with holes should not expose skin above the knee.
- Shirts and tops must have sleeves and cover the shoulders.
- Leggings, yoga pants, and other tight fitting garments are not allowed. A good rule of thumb is, if they don't have pockets they are not acceptable pants.
- All pants must extend to the knee regardless if you have something underneath them. THE
 OUTERMOST LAYER OF CLOTHING MUST INDEPENDENTLY MEET THE DRESS CODE. Example:
 if a dress is worn with leggings underneath, the dress still must extend to the knee.
